Re: <u>Request for Advisory Opinion</u>

Dear Federal Election Commission:

On behalf of our client the Northrop Grumman Corporation ("Northrop Grumman") and pursuant to 2 U.S.C. Section 437f and 11 CFR Part 112, we request a Federal Election Commission advisory opinion on the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations to a proposed consolidation of payroll deduction operations of two affiliated, but still separate, separate segregated funds (SSFs).

Specifically, must employees of a new corporation (which was formed from the merger of two prior corporations) execute new authorizations in order for their SSF payroll deductions to be consolidated into the new corporation's SSF?

The factual background is as follows. The Northrop and Grumman Corporations recently merged, creating Northrop Grumman. As separate corporations, Northrop and Grumman had their own SSFs. Presently, Northrop Grumman is maintaining both SSFs separately, but it wishes to consolidate them into a new SSF, the Employees of Northrop Grumman PAC ("ENGPAC").

The Northrop SSF and the Grumman SSF intend to send letters to their members informing them of the formation of ENGPAC, and notifying them that their contributions which had formerly funded the Northrop SSF and the Grumman SSF will now fund ENGPAC, unless the employee terminates his or her participation via an enclosed form.

The operative language of the proposed letter (a copy of which is attached) reads "Please fill out the enclosed form if you wish to change your contribution or if you wish to terminate your participation. Otherwise, your participation will transfer automatically and your deduction will go directly through to the new PAC." Office of the General Counsel Federal Election Commission June 20, 1994 Page 2

The letters, which will be sent in advance of the actual transfers of the deductions, will, of course, contain all appropriate notices pursuant to 2 U.S.C. Section 441b(b)(3)(B) and (C) and 11 CFR Section 114.5(a)(1)-(5), including disclosing the political purposes of the fund (2 U.S.C. Section 441b(b)(3)(B) and 11 CFR Section 114.5(a)(3)) and the right to refuse to contribute without any reprisal (2 U.S.C. Section 441b(b)(3)(C) and 11 CFR Section 114.5(a)(4)). Further, the solicitation will stress the voluntary nature of an employee's participation in the PAC and the continuing right to revoke the authorization without reprisal and will disclose the merger of the two SSFs.

The facts in this case closely resemble those discussed in AO 1991-19. There, GTE and CONTEL had merged and desired to merge their SSFs. The FEC stated that CONTEL employees were not required to execute new authorizations, so long as certain conditions and the voluntariness requirement were met. It would seem, therefore, that so long as the requirements set forth above are met and the employees are given the option to revoke their authorization, a new authorization is not required.
