You indicated a need to know the specific Green affiliation of this year's Green Party candidates for federal office. The candidates that were identified who are on the ballot are individual members of the Greens/Green Party USA or they are members of a state Green Party that is affiliated with the Greens/Green Party USA. Specifically,

Jed Whittaker (US Senate) is running in Alaska, an affiliated state party.

John Grames (US House) is running in Alaska, an affiliated state party.

Abraham Guttman (US Senate) is running in New Mexico, an affiliated state party.

Jack Uhrich (US House) is running in New Mexico, an affiliated state party.

Charles Laws (US House) is running in Massachusetts, an affiliated state party.

Tom Leighton (US House) is running in New York, an affiliated state party.

Walt Sheasby and Will Yeager, both running for the US House in California, are individual members of the Greens/Green Party USA.

Mr. Whittaker, Mr. Uhrich, and Mr. Laws are also individual members of the Greens/Green Party USA.

Of the others listed, Graham Schwass; is neither a member nor is RI affiliated with the G/GPUSA. The others that were originally listed did not make it on the ballot or are not running as a Green Party candidate.
