AO 2002-12 Comments on Draft

Dear Ms. Dove:

On behalf of American Medical Security, Inc., we have the following comments on Draft Advisory Opinion 2002-12 to be considered at the Commission's December 5, 2002 meeting:

LGAX

- Page 7, lines 8-9 A vote of 80 percent of the outstanding shares is required to remove not elect a company director. See Exhibit G to July 24, 2002 Correspondence, Restated Articles of Incorporation of AMSG, Article V, Paragraph b. ("A director may be removed from office only by affirmative vote of at least 80 percent of the outstanding shares entitled to vote for the election of such director...."). Only after a director has been removed will a resulting vacancy be filled by an 80 percent affirmative vote of outstanding shares. In all other instances, a vacancy is filled by the remaining members of the Board or, in the absence of action by the remaining directors, by the shareholders. If elected by the shareholders, directors are elected by a plurality of votes cast by shares entitled to vote in an election at a shareholders' meeting at which a quorum is present. A majority vote of the outstanding shares constitutes a quorum. "Plurality" means that the individuals who receive the largest number of votes are elected as directors up to the maximum number of directors to be chosen in the election.
- Page 11, lines 3-4 Same revision necessary: a vote of 80 percent of the outstanding shares is required to remove not elect a company director. Id.
