Commissioner Thomas has moved for reconsideration of Advisory Opinion 2004-12 (attached) at the June 24 Open Session. Commission Directive 10 ("Rules of Procedure of the Federal Election Commission Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 437c(e)") sets forth procedures applicable to such motions. Specifically, it states that the "effect of the adoption of a motion to reconsider is to place before the Commission again the question on which the vote to reconsider was taken in the exact position in which it was before the original vote."
