Dear FEC -

Repledge recently submitted a new AOR, 2015-08 which appears to be substantially equivalent to its prior AOR, 2012-08, which deadlocked.

As a commenter interested in this issue, we ask that the Commission request Repledge to submit additional materials clearly explaining

- a) in what way, if any, the proposal, facts, or circumstances presented in AOR 2015-08 differs from that in AOR 2012-08, and
- b) in what way, if any, intervening case law or advisory opinions should make the analysis different than it was for AOR 2012-08.

With the current form of the request, it is difficult to understand

why the outcome should not be the same as it was last time.

Without clarification distinguishing the two requests, public commenters, the Commission, and any Commission precedent established

by an AO on this matter will be confused.

We further request that the Commission extend the time for comments to

30 days after the above supplement has been published, and to be notified of all updates on this AOR.
