**Agreement of Voluntary Dismissal of Appeal** 

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 42(b) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, the undersigned, who are all of the parties to the above-captioned appeal, stipulate and agree that this appeal should be dismissed. Each party shall bear its own costs.

This dismissal is made for the purpose of focusing on the trial on the merits in the District Court. The District Court stayed proceedings on January 8, 2009, but has lifted that stay as of February 8, 2010, and ordered discovery to commence. Appellants Holly Lynn Koerber and Committee for Truth in Politics, Inc. no longer wish to pursue the appeal of the denial of their preliminary injunction.
