# INTERVENOR-PLAINTIFF AMERICAN FUTURE PAC'S SUPPLEMENTAL PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Intervenor-Plaintiff American Future PAC hereby submits its proposed supplemental findings of fact and conclusions of law in the above-captioned case:

#### **Proposed Findings of Fact**

- 1. American Future PAC ("American Future") filed FEC Form 1 to register as a political committee with the FEC on August 5, 2014, and the form was received by the FEC on August 11, 2014. *See* Declaration of Jared Najvar, Doc. #50-3, ¶ 3 & Ex. 1 (Aug. 27, 2014) ("Najvar Decl.").
- 2. Following its creation, American Future contributed to five candidates for federal office. Among those contributions was a contribution for \$2,600 to Congressman Cotton, in

connection with the November 2014 general election for U.S. Senate. Najvar Decl. ¶ 4.

3. The cover letter from American Future to Congressman Tom Cotton that

accompanied its contribution to him explains that, but for the unconstitutionally discriminatory

six-month waiting period American Future seeks to challenge in this case, it would have made a

larger contribution to him. Najvar Decl., ¶ 5.

4. Since its creation, American Future received 54 contributions from different

individuals. Najvar Decl. ¶ 6.

5. Since its creation, American Future collected over \$5,400 in contributions. Najvar

Decl. ¶ 7.

6. But for the unconstitutional provisions of federal law American Future wishes to

challenge in this case, American Future would have contributed an additional \$2,000 to

Congressman Tom Cotton in connection with the 2014 general election. Najvar Decl., ¶ 8.

7. American Future has received more than 51 contributions, made contributions to

five federal candidates, and has been registered with the FEC for less than six months. Najvar

Decl., ¶ 9.

**Conclusions of Law** 

American Future is asserting the same constitutional claims as Plaintiff Stop PAC, and

respectfully adopts, joins in, and incorporates by reference the arguments presented by Stop PAC

in support of its motion for summary judgment and in opposition to the FEC's motion for summary

judgment.
